#### Inclusion criteria

#### Exclusion criteria (For female subjects only. Please skip this for male subjects)

**\* Note:** All the women under the age of 55 and can't confirm their non-pregnancy status by medical record documentation will be asked to see whether they want to take a urine pregnancy test at our clinic recruitment site. If the subject refuses to take the urine pregnancy test, she will NOT be enrolled into the study. If the subject agrees, she will be provided with a urine pregnancy test at our clinical site prior to performing clinical procedures (including the bone density scan). If the pregnancy test is positive, the subject will NOT be enrolled into the study. The performance of the urine pregnancy test and the result are documented in a separate file.

#### Exclusion criteria (continue) (All the following are based on the subject's answers)

		Female subjects who have had bilateral oophorectomy ( <b>leave blank for male subjects</b> )
		Serious residuals from cerebral vascular disease
		Diabetes mellitus, except for those controlled under medication
		Chronic renal failure
		Chronic liver failure
		Alcohol abuse as defined by those who cannot limit drinking, get drunk regularly, and cannot fulfill major responsibilities at work, school, or home.
		Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)
		Corticosteroid therapy at therapeutic levels for more than 6 months duration
		Treatment with anticonvulsant therapy for more than 6 months duration
		Evidence of other metabolic or inherited bone disease such as hyper- or hypoparathyroidism, Paget's disease, osteomalacia, osteogenesis imperfecta or others
		Rheumatoid arthritis (except for minor cases that involve only hand joint and wrist)
		Collagen disease (i.e., Osteogenesis imperfecta and Hypochondrogenesis)
		Chronic gastrointestinal diseases including celiac disease, postgastrectomy, Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis, liver transplant, cirrhosis

Since our DEXA machine cannot operate if the subject's body weight is **over 300 pounds**, we will not recruit subjects whose body weight is over 300 pounds.
