



NSPE FUNDAMENTAL CANONS: RULES OF PRACTICE

- Maintain safety, health & public welfare
- Perform services only in area of competence
- Public statements must be objective and truthful
- Be a faithful agent or trustee in representing employer or client
- Avoid deception in solicitation of professional employment

NSPE CODE OF ETHICS: PROFESSIONAL OBLIGATIONS

- Highest standards of integrity in professional relations
- Strive to serve public interest at all times
- Avoid conduct or practice which discredits profession or deceives public
- Do not disclose confidential business or technical information without client/employer consent
- Duties not influenced by conflicting interests

NSPE CODE OF ETHICS: PROFESSIONAL OBLIGATIONS (Cont)

- Uphold principle of appropriate & adequate compensation
- Will not untruthfully criticize other engineers in seeking employment or advancement
- Will not maliciously or falsely injure professional reputation of other engineers.
