IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

The petition and amended petition clearly state unambiguous and factually supported causes of actions and allegations. For those reasons, the Exception of Nonconformity of The Petitions to Article 891 is overruled.

The petitions are well pleaded and the Exception of Vagueness and Ambiguity is overruled.

The Exception of Lack of Procedural Capacity is overruled.

The Exception pf Prematurity is overruled.

The Exception of Improper Cumulation of Actions is overruled.

The Exception of Failure to Join All Necessary Parties is overruled.

The Exception of Failure to Join All Indispensable Parties is overruled.

The Exception of No Right of Action is overruled.

The Exception of No Cause of Action is overruled.

Plaintiff's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment is granted as relates to First Amended Petition Count I, which concerns the Open Meetings Act. La R.S.42:4.1 et seq (2003); Count II, which concerns La. R.S.33:4169.1A(3); and Count IV, which concerns Section 9-25 of the St. Helena Parish Code of Ordinances. No genuine issue as to material fact exists as relates to these counts and plaintiffs are entitled to summary judgment as a matter of law declaring the agreement with MRR St. Helena, LLC ("MRR") null, and void. Therefore,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the "Host Agreement Relative to MRR St. Helena, LLC Landfill, Host Fee Payments to Host Parish from Landfill Operations and Matters Related Thereto" dated 9 September 2003 by and between the Parish of St. Helena and MRR St. Helena, LLC be and the same is declared to be an absolute nullity, void <u>ab initio</u>, of no force and effect, and unenforceable by either party.
